COURSE DETAILS:

Duration: This course is delivered over a period of 446 hours, comprising classroom sessions, practical placement, Private research and study time.

Format: Classroom based training and supervised practical experience in a Health Care Facility

Purpose: This certificate course provides you with a holistic approach to working in a Health Care Environment. It is designed to equip you with the knowledge & skills to provide assistance to health profession staff with the care of clients. Health Service Assistance involves the worker in direct client contact under supervision.

Who Should Attend:

People who are interested in undertaking a range of varied support service functions and tasks requiring discretion and judgement. This qualification is suited to people looking to become a nursing assistant, orderly, or ward assistant.

Pre-

Requisites: Proficiency in English to Industry Standards. Applicants may be asked to undertake a Language, Literacy & Numeracy Assessment.

Recognition: This course holds National Accreditation.

Assessment: Assessments will be conducted to determine the achievement of competency-based learning outcomes. Assessments may include written assignments, practical skill demonstration, participation in role play, and workplace observations

Pathway: Successful completion of this course will enable you to progress to Certificate IV in Health Support Services (Supervision), or to gain employment as an Orderly, Nursing support worker, Patient service attendant, Ward assistant, Patient support assistant, Wardperson or Patient care assistant
